

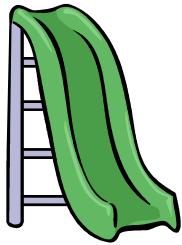
CITY OF KAUFMAN PARKS

All city parks shall be closed from 10 pm to 6 am, except for league play at the Kaufman Sports Complex and specially scheduled permitted functions at any of the parks. The City of Kaufman has over 622 acres of park land and lakes for your enjoyment.

Brin Garden is located on the corner of Washington Street and Mulberry Street which is 0.027 acres. You can relax for a few minutes at one of the benches or at the picnic table, as you watch the hustle and bustle go by.



Cottage Heights Park is located in the northeast part of Kaufman at the corner of Second Street and Dellis Street. The park sets on 0.23 acres and has two picnic tables, with grills, and individually covered pavilions. A playground is located near the picnic tables.



Kaufman City Lake Park is located in the northeast part of Kaufman off of Highway 34. The park sets on 232.2 acres and it offers many different varieties of recreational leisure enjoyment. If you like fishing, boating, hiking, picnicking, etc., then this is the park for you. A playground is located near the picnic tables.

Kaufman City Lake is located off of Highway 234 about 3 miles from the City limits which covers 283 acres. If you like fishing then this is the park for you.

Kaufman Sports Complex is our newest park, located on the north side of town off of Highway 34. This 81 acre park provides the opportunity for all types of sports and games including: soccer, softball, baseball, T-Ball, football and tennis. There is also a 7/8 mile concrete walking trail around the fields. A playground area is located next to the covered pavilion.

- ❖ To use the tennis courts you will need to come to the Public Works Department and complete an application form and pay a refundable key deposit of \$20. Public Works is located at 1003 W. Grove Street and opened Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Melody Circle Park is located in the northeast part of Kaufman on Melody Circle and is 0.39 acres. It offers a ½ basketball court, sand box and picnic area.

Phillips Circle Open Area is located in the east part of Kaufman on Phillips Circle. It has a large natural open area of 4 acres for City residents to use. It is a great place for touch football or just flying a kite!

Prairie Creek Open Area is located in the east part of Kaufman off of Rand Road and Melody Drive off of Ridgebriar Drive. It has a large natural open area of 19 acres for City residents to use. It is a great place for hiking and watching nature!



Shannon Park is located in the north-west part of Kaufman at the corner of Barnes Street and Shannon Street. The park sets on 2.2 acres offering three shaded areas with picnic tables. Two of them have charcoal grills for your outdoor cooking. A playground area is located near the picnic tables.
