KCSO Notices Regarding COVID-19 Directives

March 13, 2020

Notice – Effective Immediately

In an attempt to contain and/or prevent the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) the following directive is in effect. All inmate visitations (County inmates and Contract inmates) are suspended. In accordance with section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code, the Office of the Governor has granted the Texas Commission on Jail Standards request to allow County Jails to suspend all inmate visitations. This suspension will be re-evaluated on a week to week basis as long as the Disaster Declaration is in effect.

Attention Family Members of Kaufman County Inmates:

As you are aware visitation with inmates has been canceled for precautionary efforts relating to COVID-19.

In an effort to provide some type of visitation between inmates and their family members, KCSO has reached an agreement with NCIC Inmate Phone Service. Each inmate will be allowed to make four (4), five (5) minute phone calls free of charge per week as long as the visitation restriction is in place. When the restriction is lifted and face to face visitation may be resumed KCSO will notify inmates and the public.

We know this is a difficult time for families of those incarcerated. We appreciate your understanding and patience.
