

GUIDELINES

For visibility and safety reasons, runs are not allowed during dark hours, regardless if it is at night or early mornings.

The City does not have the authority to permit runs on state roads and state highways. That includes Washington Street and Ed Hall Drive.

Do not park any vehicles on private property unless you obtain the owner's permission.

Do not block any driveways inhibiting the ability to get in or out.

Food sales are allowed after obtaining a temporary food permit.

5K Runs In the City of Kaufman

These guidelines are to make your 5K run as fun and safe as possible. The runners' safety is our first and foremost concern, so please follow all guidelines in this brochure.



REQUIREMENTS

The City of Kaufman can't provide any staff, firefighters, or police officers for your event.


You will need to provide a stationary car, with its flashers on, near the entrance of Highway 175 during the entire run. The runners will have the right lane to continue on to South Houston Street. **DO NOT BLOCK THE ENTRANCE TO HIGHWAY 175.**

You will need to provide two cars, with their flashers on, to escort the runners. One car will be at the front of the first runner and one car will follow the last runner.

You will need to provide safety cones to close off the staging and finishing areas only.

Please clean up any and all trash from your event.

The attached route shown has been pre-approved and is the safest and most economical route in the City of Kaufman.



PARKING — The runners may park at the City of Kaufman City Hall located at 209 S. Washington or at the Kaufman County parking lots located in the 200 block of South Jackson or 200 block of East Mulberry. Please obtain permission from the property owner before parking in the 300 block of South Jackson Street.
